
Premium ingredients – like real butter, free-range eggs, Belgian chocolate, gluten-free or allergen-safe alternatives.

## TIME ADDS UP QUICKLY

Even the simplest custom cake can take hours:

- 1-2 hours to bake and prep the layers
- 2-5 hours to stack, fill, decorate and add toppers or fondant details
- 1-2 hours spent chatting with you, confirming your design, buying ingredients, and prepping for delivery

That's often **8+ hours** for a single order — not including admin or business overheads.

Many bakers earn less than minimum wage when all the hours are counted.

A single fondant animal topper can take 1–2 hours to create – by hand.
That's time, tools, and talent that adds up.


#### Ask yourself:

- Will I collect it, or do I need delivery?


Being clear on what you need helps the baker give you the best options within your budget.


